Upon returning to Seward you will say goodbye to your local guide and be transferred to your cruise terminal in Whittier for a 7 night Alaskan Cruise! Tonight board the Norwegian Jade for an unforgettable journey! (B, L, D)

Day 6 - Tuesday July 7th

Breathtaking and exciting, Icy Strait Point truly takes you where the wild things are. It's one of the few places in the world where wildlife outnumbers the human population. A trip here certainly satisfies your taste for adventure. Take a cruise from Icy Strait Point and enjoy Alaska's awe-inspiring scenery and the many excursion options that Norwegian Cruise Line has to offer. (B, L, D)

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Day 8 - Thursday July 9th

This is why visitors come to Alaska—to see glaciers as magnificent as Dawes—and getting there is half the excitement. From Stephens Passage, your ship will turn into the glacially carved fjord of Endicott Arm, the southern sister fjord to Tracy. However, Endicott is special. It's the fjord less travelled, and at its head, Dawes Glacier. But first, the 31-mile fjord. Sheer granite walls. Plunging waterfalls. Spruce and hemlock trees clinging to the steep sides. It is the definition of pristine. Look for "bergy bits," floating chunks of glacial ice, some looking more like sculptures, some with resting seals on top. Keep an eye open for bears, mountain goats and whales, too. As we approach the glacier, listen for thunderous cracks and have your camera ready. Dawes is an active tidewater glacier that recedes daily causing calving, where huge hunks of ice plunge into the sea. At 600 feet tall and a half-mile wide, this blue-hued, powerful glacier may be the highlight of your Alaska cruise. Juneau has been called "Alaska's peak experience," certainly due in part to its unparalleled glacier viewing from such places as Tracy Arm Fjord, the Juneau Icefields and Glacier Bay National Park. Kayak up one of the area's many protected waterways, go flightseeing, tour historic downtown or try your hand at panning for gold. (B, L, D)

Day 9 - Friday July 10th

In a single year from 1896 to 1897, this remote town along the Inside Passage, Skagway, grew from a few tents to a city of 20,000 gold seekers. Today, travelers come in search of other riches – to experience yesteryear along Skagway's charming boardwalk lined with buildings that replicate those Gold Rush days. (B, L, D)

Day 10 - Saturday July 11th

Its Tlingit Indian name, Kach Khanna, means "spread wings of the eagle." Chances are you'll see one of these magnificent birds perched atop a Sitka tree. Thanks to its abundant rainfall, Ketchikan is surrounded by some of the world's most lush wilderness. (B, L, D)

Day 11 - Sunday July 12th

Get ready for amazing views and wildlife like nowhere else as you sail through the islands of Alaska's Inside Passage. The inside Passage is a coastal route for ships and boats along a network of passages which weave through the islands on the Pacific Northwest coast of the North American Fjordland. The most popular way to explore the Inside Passage during summer is by cruise ship. Over 2 million people take cruises each year in this region! Enjoy this day milling about on the cruise ship with your friends, or a long walk out on the ships boardwalk! (B, L D)

Day 12 - Monday July 13th

Positioned between the snow-dusted North Shore Mountains and the rich, blue waters of the Pacific Ocean, Vancouver blends big-city sophistication with small-town charm. Don't miss Queen Elizabeth Park – a 130-acre civic arboretum accented with sculptures by modern artist Henry Moore. Today you will disembark the Jade and be transported to the airport in Vancouver for your return trip home. This will certainly have been the bucket list Alaskan adventure you have been dreaming of! - a. Clothes: Layers

- b. Other helpful tidbits: Compact umbrella, sleeping eye masks, dramamine, waterproof phone covers, small travel backpacks for daily travel, passport, driver's license, spending money, sunscreen, mosquito repellent, binoculars.
