

This itinerary combines both Excites pre and post days and experiences along with Azamara's schedule while on board. All cruise excursions, accommodations, etc should be handled with Shelby at Goodrum Getaways.

**Day 1 (June 24th)** - Your journey begins as you board an overnight international flight bound for Portugal. Relax and get ready to experience the beauty of Europe's Atlantic and North Sea coasts.

**Day 2 (June 25<sup>th</sup>)** - Arrive in Lisbon, Portugal's luminous capital, where history and modern life weave seamlessly together. Settled on seven hills overlooking the Tagus River, Lisbon has been a crossroads of cultures for centuries — from Phoenicians and Romans to Moors and explorers who launched the Age of Discovery from its shores.

**Day 2 Cont** - After checking into your elegant hotel, enjoy time to refresh before heading out to take in the city's charm. Wander the narrow lanes of Alfama, hear echoes of fado music drifting from cafés, and admire the decorative azulejo tiles that line facades in blue and gold. This evening, gather with your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner and performance of fado — Portugal's soulful musical tradition — as you settle into the rhythms of Europe. (D)

**Day 3 (June 26<sup>th</sup>)** - Enjoy breakfast at your hotel, then set off to discover why Lisbon has captivated travelers for centuries. See the soaring Gothic arches of Jerónimos Monastery, admire the Tower of Belém guarding the Tagus River, and take in sweeping city views from São Jorge Castle. After lunch on your own, stroll the city's grand plazas or ride one of the famous yellow trams through hilly neighborhoods. This afternoon, we transfer to the port and step aboard the Azamara Journey. Settle into your stateroom, then gather this evening for a festive sail-away and welcome dinner as our voyage begins. (B, D)





**Day 4 (June 27th) Porto (Leixões), Portugal** – Wake to the lush hillsides of northern Portugal. A short transfer brings us into Porto, a city of bridges, baroque churches, and winding lanes along the Douro River. We'll visit the colorful Ribeira district, then cross the Dom Luís I Bridge to explore Vila Nova de Gaia, home to the world's most famous port wine lodges. Enjoy a tasting of the region's celebrated vintages and soak in panoramic views over the city. In the afternoon, choose to wander the tiled churches, shop for hand-painted ceramics, or relax in a café before returning to the ship. (B, L, D)

**Day 5 – (June 28) – Ferrol, Spain** – Today brings us to Galicia, a region shaped by the sea. In Ferrol, once the heart of Spain's naval fleet, we'll see fortifications, historic shipyards, and lively squares. Stroll the old quarter or opt for a drive along the rugged Atlantic coastline where fishing villages cling to rocky cliffs.



**Day 5 (cont)** – Galicia is famous for its cuisine, and lunch might include pulpo a la gallega (octopus) or fresh shellfish paired with Albariño wine. (B, L, D)

**Day 6 (June 29) Day at Sea** – A day to unwind and savor the boutique luxury of Azamara. Join a lecture on European history, try a cooking class, book a spa treatment, or simply relax on deck with the ocean as your backdrop. As evening falls, enjoy a cocktail at sunset followed by dinner in one of the ship's specialty restaurants. (B, L, D)

**Day 7 (June 30) Saint-Malo, France** – Dock in Saint-Malo, a walled city steeped in pirate lore and maritime history. Walk atop the ancient ramparts for sweeping views of the Channel, then step into cobblestoned streets filled with shops, cafés, and crêperies.

**Day 7 (cont)** – Those who wish may join an excursion to Mont-Saint-Michel, the dramatic abbey perched on a tidal island – one of France's most awe-inspiring sites. This evening, return to the ship with a taste of Brittany's seafaring spirit. (B, L, D)

**Day 8 (July 1) - Honfleur, France** – Charming Honfleur welcomes us with half-timbered houses and a harbor that inspired Monet and Boudin. Explore Sainte-Catherine's Church, the largest wooden church in France, or wander through art galleries and boutique shops. Sample fresh mussels or oysters along the quayside, paired with crisp Normandy cider. It's a slower-paced stop that allows time to savor France's gentle countryside and its celebrated cuisine. (B, L, D)

**Day 9 – July 2: Dover (London), England** – Arrive at Dover, framed by the iconic White Cliffs. Stay local to explore Dover Castle and its medieval tunnels, or opt for a full-day excursion to London. See Buckingham Palace, the Houses of Parliament, and Tower Bridge, or spend time in the British Museum. This evening, return to the ship with memories of England's past and present. (B, L, D)

## **Day 10 – July 3: Zeebrugge (Bruges), Belgium**

Belgium's medieval gem awaits. From Zeebrugge, travel to Bruges – a city of canals, gabled houses, and soaring church spires. Take a canal cruise, climb the Belfry Tower, or shop for handmade lace and artisanal chocolates. Pause in a centuries-old tavern for Belgian beer before returning to the ship. (B, L, D)

**Day 11 – July 4: Ijmuiden (Amsterdam), Netherlands** – Celebrate Independence Day in Amsterdam, a city of canals and creativity. Tour the Rijksmuseum or Van Gogh Museum, enjoy a canal cruise, or rent a bike to explore neighborhoods like Jordaan. Sample Dutch pancakes or cheese, then return for a festive evening onboard marking the holiday. (B, L, D)

**Day 12 – July 5: Hamburg, Germany** – Arrive in Hamburg this afternoon. Tour the historic Speicherstadt warehouse district, marvel at the futuristic Elbphilharmonie concert hall, and stroll the lively harborfront. Enjoy an evening at leisure to try Northern German specialties in the city's vibrant dining scene. (B, L, D)





**Day 13 – July 6: Hamburg, Germany** – A second full day lets you dig deeper. Visit Lübeck, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for Gothic brick architecture and marzipan, or remain in Hamburg to explore museums, parks, and lakeside promenades. With its mix of tradition and trendsetting culture, Hamburg offers discoveries at every turn. (B, L, D)

**Day 14 – July 7: Kiel Canal Transit** – Sail through the Kiel Canal, a 61-mile passage linking the North Sea to the Baltic. This scenic voyage passes rolling fields, windmills, and tiny villages – a perfect day for photography or simply watching life along the water. Relax onboard and take in this engineering marvel from the comfort of your ship. (B, L, D)

**Day 15 – July 8: Fredericia, Denmark** – Founded as a fortress town in the 1600s, Fredericia offers a glimpse into Denmark's proud history. Walk along its preserved ramparts, visit local shops and cafés, or join an excursion to Odense, birthplace of Hans Christian Andersen. Whether you choose history, culture, or relaxation, today brings a true taste of Danish hospitality. (B, L, D)

**Day 16 – July 9: Copenhagen, Denmark** – Disembark in Copenhagen, a city of castles, canals, and cutting-edge design. Visit the Little Mermaid statue, stroll Nyhavn's colorful harbor, and see Amalienborg Palace. Those with extra time may wander Tivoli Gardens or explore the city's thriving food scene. Tonight, gather for a farewell dinner, reflecting on the extraordinary journey behind you. (B, D)

**Day 17 – July 10: Depart for USA**

Enjoy one last day in Denmark, enjoying a beautiful breakfast, and perhaps a walk in Copenhagen. Later this morning, you will depart for the airport for your flight home! (B)
